Mr. Horn is the founder of Horn & Co, Law Offices. The firm comprises 18 lawyers and three articulated clerks, and represents technology based companies, their founders, investors and board members.

Mr. Horn regularly advises his clients on international transactions, including mergers and acquisitions, public offerings (US, EU, Israel), initial coin offerings, structured finance, and corporate reorganizations, as well as on all legal aspects of operations of high tech and life sciences companies, including licensing and sale of technology, joint ventures, commercial transactions and labor law issues.
